Core Curriculum:

Language Arts

The students will continue to work in their guided reading groups on their good fit books focusing on reading with expression, improving fluency, comprehension and story vocabulary.

The students will be starting to write their "Knight and Dragon" story very soon. Within the story they will be incorporating adjectives, verbs, adverbs, comparisons and prepositions. I am hopeful the stories will be interesting to read and show good imagination.

Thank you for your support with the "Home Reading" program, The Tower of Books Challenge. Please continue to encourage your child to read different genres to help gain more fluency and confidence when reading.

Social Studies

The students will start their unit on Living with the Land next week. This unit includes First Nations, Fur Trade, and Settling the Land. This is a rather large unit and will take us right to the middle of May. Any students with items they would like to bring in that relate to this unit are more than welcome.

Math

The students are currently working on their "Multiplication and Division Facts" unit. They have been working with different strategies to solve problems. Ask your child to show the strategies we have been learning about. Continue to practice their basic facts every night towards mastery.
