To assist in this process we have created the following schedule for our students and families to follow. INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Wipe down, the borrowed device & charging cord with a Lysol Wipe or other disinfectant.
- 2. At the appropriate time and date, return the device to the school, 69 Douglas Avenue, by entering the school parking lot via the drop and go entrance.
- 3. Within the loop, you will see clearly marked tables arranged by the first letter of the last name.
- 4. Parents are asked to drive up beside the appropriate table and leave their borrowed device and charging cord on the table.
- 5. A staff member will be there (at a social distance) to assist with the collection of the devices.
- 6. If parents have a library book or other school materials they need to return, they may do so at this time as well.
- 7. Damaged, or not working devices need to be identified, so please let us know if there is a problem with the device that your child has borrowed.
